High Park School Improvement Plan 2023-24 Overview

The School Improvement Plan identifies the key priorities we will be focussing on to secure the best outcomes for our pupils.

Quality of Education

- Review the curriculum to ensure that it is aspirational and meets the needs of all pupils across the school.
- The PE curriculum is reviewed to ensure that it reflects a broad and balanced offer incorporating meaningful opportunities for athletics, dance, gymnastics and outdoor activities.
- The reading/writing curriculum is developed to increase pupils' motivations and skills in functional reading & writing.
- Develop the maths curriculum to ensure clear progression for pupils and improve skills of staff to teach maths effectively.
- The AQA programme is extended to provide further opportunities for pupils to extend their skills and knowledge in PfA.

Behaviour and Attitudes

- Staff development in place in initiating and extending engagement opportunities for pupils.
- Review of how Behaviour Incidents are recorded and reported with a view to having a streamlined electronic system in place.

Personal Development

- Parents/carers are better connected through the school community.
- Maximise learning opportunities and progress during community activities to develop greater independence and resilience in unpredictable environments, events and situations.

Leadership and Management

- Increase leadership capacity across the school in the context of the management of change (new Principal, new Base Leaders, reduced SLT, reduced BST, working with the CAT).
- Ensure that funding for each pupil reflects the resources and support required to access a broad and balanced curriculum.
