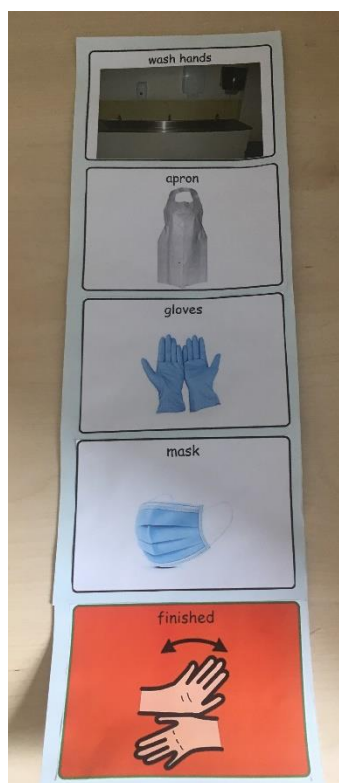


## PPE desensitisation routine



### Aims:

- to encourage pupils to become familiar with other people wearing face masks, particularly during hygiene routines.

### To complete the routine with a pupil, you will need the following equipment:

- Face mask, gloves and apron.
- Visual routine (as pictured) (located on t drive > boardmaker > BM resources > PDFs for printing > health check visuals > PPE routine (official)).
- This will be located in each pupil bathroom.

### How to use:

1. Adult to bring pupil to the toilet with the 'toilet' Object of Reference.
2. Adult to point to (try not to touch) the first step 'wash hands'. Say 'wash hands', then adult to wash hands following the NHS Handwashing Guidance.
3. Adult to point to the next step and say, 'apron', then put on the apron.
4. Adult to point to the next step and say, 'gloves', then put on the gloves.
5. Adult to point to the next step and say, 'mask', then put on the mask.
6. Adult to proceed to complete the hygiene routine with pupil.
7. When finished, adult to point to the 'finished' symbol.
8. During the process, if a pupil reacts to the PPE, adult to calmly point to the relevant visual and say 'yes, mask', 'yes apron' or 'yes gloves.'
